Wildflower Hike - Saturday, May 7, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. Rain or Shine For those who have never been to the Treat Farm in Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore, you will have a treat (no pun intended). Even those who have gone on this hike in previous years will enjoy the spectacular displays of spring wildflowers. There is probably no more magnificent showing of wildflowers in northern Michigan than in the northern hardwood forest leading to the old farmstead. The approximately two-hour hike is easy and you will be treated to a huge display of the best that Nature has to offer.

We will meet at the Treat Farm entrance gate, which is located near the west end of Stormer Road about a mile south of the Empire Village limits on M22. If coming south from Empire, turn right on Stormer and drive about a half mile to the point where there is a sharp curve to the left. You can park your vehicles anywhere along the side of the road, but be sure to display a National Park pass in your parked vehicle.
