News from the RVC3

As you read this, the AG may be in full swing - or for those local groups with a publication deadline of thirty days prior, this will appear in your August newsletter.

Although Indianapolis is in Region 4, it is still in the Midwest and more easily accessible to those of us in Region 3. I am looking forward to seeing many of you there. I am also attending the Colloquium since the topic is on the future of manufacturing and having worked in the IT area of automotive suppliers most of the last thirty years, I am curious as to what experts in the field have to say.

This also begins the second year of my term as Regional Vice Chair for Region 3. I am gratified that the members of the AMC have very divergent opinions on some topics - even though this sometimes means that discussion on a single topic may take an hour or so while we all express and discuss our thoughts and viewpoints. Fortunately, this has been done with mutual respect.

Each year there are four AMC meetings. One is scheduled during the AG which makes it possible for more members to attend. The fall one is held in September at American Mensa HQ in order to allow some interaction with the staff. This past year, I spent significant time interacting with Becky Folger, the Local Groups liaison. She is a real gem and will extend herself in serving the local groups.
